## **Late Justice SC Agrawal**

(Former Judge, Supreme Court of India)

Late Justice SC Agrawal (1933-2021) was a renowned Judge of Supreme Court of India & the Rajasthan High Court. He served as President of Rajasthan Education Trust and was also the founding trustee of CL Agrawal Memorial (CLAM) Library Trust, Rajasthan High Court, Jaipur.

Justice Agrawal was born in Jaipur in 1933. After finishing his LLB studies from University of Rajasthan, he did his LLM from the University of London and became Bar-At-Law in 1957. He joined the Supreme Court of India Bar in 1959. He was appointed Additional Judge of the Rajasthan High Court on 15th June 1978 from where he was elevated to Supreme Court of India "SCI" on 11th Jan. 1990. He retired from the SCI in September 1998. He delivered several landmark judgements both at Rajasthan High Court and Supreme Court and commanded great respect as an eminent Judge of both courts.

After his retirement from SCI, he engaged himself in several charity activities continuing the legacy of his father Late Sh. Chiranji Lal Agrawal (Advocate) through Rajasthan Education Trust, where he served as President till his passing away in July 2021.

He also served as President of Association of Retired Judges of Supreme Court & High Courts of India for two years. He donated his entire property to charity.

### Hon'ble Mr. Justice R.S. Chauhan

(Former Chief Justice, Uttarakhand High Court)

Justice Chauhan was born in Nepal, and educated in UnitedStates and India. He got his law degree from Delhi University Law College, and started his legal practice in 1983 at Rajasthan High Court. After practicing there from 1983 to 2005, he was elevated as a Judge of the Rajasthan High Court on June 13, 2005 and served in that position till March 2015.

From March 2015 to November 2018, he served as a Senior Judge of the Karnataka High Court. He was elevated as the Chief Justice of High Court of Telangana in June, 2019. During this period, he was also the Chancellor of National Academy of Legal Studies and Research (NALSAR), Hyderabad. He joined the Uttarakhand High Court as the Chief Justice on January 07, 2021and retired as Chief Justice on December 23, 2021.

Justice Chauhan has been working as an Arbitrator, both nationally and internationally, ever since then. He has published various articles on Law and Art History both in national and international journals. He has also authored two books: one on Criminal Law and the other on Flowers. He has also delivered numerous lectures both on Law and on Indian and Western Art History.
